## A new vision for public, affordable and sustainable homes for all

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#### **National Housing Policy**



We need above all else a:

- National Housing Policy
- Minimum 20 Years
- Cross party agreement to key elements
- Housing supply never responds as fast as policymakers would like so long-term housing policies are needed

#### **Public Housing**



- We need to build and continue to build public housing on a large scale
- Social Housing
- Cost Rental Housing

#### **State Land**



# State land should be kept in State Ownership

#### **Affordability**



- Housing needs to be affordable to buy or rent
- Initially max. of 35% of household income on moderate income
- Long-term should be max. of 15% to 20% of household income


#### **Investment Funding**

- Better public and sustainable transport
- Better services and amenities

Ensure access to decent, adequate, affordable and healthy housing for all



#### Planning for Sustainable Development



- Change is needed

- It is not sustainable or desirable for everyone to live in low density housing
- We must provide housing that meets the needs of our population, at all stages of their lives
