- People wishing to enhance their broader communication skills and their capability of addressing concerns arising in relationships with others (commercial, workplace, personal etc.)

Expand your knowledge about the process of repairing and restoring relationships across various areas of your life. Develop your practical skills for restorative practices in a structured learning environment. Build your confidence to be able to create a safe space and a sense of community for people. Applicants should have a minimum 2.2 grade, honours (level 8) degree. However, this course is also open to experienced professionals who do not hold a primary degree.
