

Master's in Anthropology



A one-year taught programme for students who are curious about diverse forms of social and cultural life worldwide.

The course equips students to tackle real-world challenges, including new digital and environmental infrastructures, cross-cultural understanding in the context of globalisation, and inequalities both within and between societies. Anthropologists investigate the links between the global and the local, between abstract theory and everyday practices, as well as the intersections of various institutional dimensions of social life: creative, political, medical, economic, religious, technological, familial, and more.

We offer a wide variety of options for postgraduate study, including:

- MA (1 yr, 3 Semester/90 ECTSs)
- MA (Part-time, 90 ECTS over two years, open to international and Irish students)
- MA CREOLE (2 yr 120 ECTS, 2 Semesters Erasmus @ partners)
- M.Litt. (2 Yr Research Degree)
- Postgraduate Certificate, a 40ECTS degree over 1 year.
