The 1916 Bursary Fund is a targeted funding scheme established by the Department of Education and Skills to support the implementation of the National Plan for Equity of Access to Higher Education 2015-2019.

You may be eligible for a 1916 Bursary Award if:

- Your household reckonable income was less than €24,500 for 2021,
- You belong to one of the 1916 Bursary Fund priority groups (i.e. Lone Parent, Irish Traveller, Person experiencing Homelessness, Person with a Disability, Member of an Ethnic Minority, Is/Was in Care of the State),
- You are a first-time applicant to a full or part-time undergraduate course (including mature students and Further Education Award Holders) in September 2022.

The bursary will fund the entire duration of your programme of study and will also be paid as you progress to postgraduate study.
