




















PPI Ignite was born...

"Nothing about us, without us"



- o Starting from the lowest rung of manipulation to highest level of citizen control where power is transferred from government to the people.








Roger Hart's (1992)Ladder of Young People's










IAP2 Spectrum of Public Participation










PPI spectrum of involvement
