

## International Education Committee – Terms of Reference

The role of the Academic Council International Education Committee is to make recommendations to Academic Council on matters of strategy and policy in relation to internationalization and to oversee on behalf of Academic Council the growth and development of international programmes across the university.

The remit of the Committee, reporting to and subject to oversight and review by Academic Council, is to:

- oversee, on behalf of Academic Council, the development, implementation and review of the strategies for internationalization for the university, within the overall framework of the University Strategic Plan;
- develop policies and initiatives to
  - enhance the portfolio of taught International programmes;
  - enhance the International student experience;
- make recommendations to Academic Council on matters pertaining to international scholastic funding as a means of supporting growth in International enrolments;
- develop policies and initiatives to enhance international education and training;
- where appropriate, to co-ordinate and align Faculty initiatives and plans to enhance and expand international education;
- review annually available metrics on the performance of the University in internationalization;
- receive and comment on reports from the International Office;
- recommend to the Academic Programmes Committee changes to the regulations governing the academic programmes of the university which, in the view of the International Education Committee, would enhance internationalization.
