How we will communicate with you

We keep in touch with you using email, Moodle, Microsoft Teams, through meetings

and by phone.

If we want to get in touch with you personally, we will generally email you (to your

mumail.ie address). You should check this email account regularly (at least daily).

If we want to share information about a module, we will do this during lectures/seminars

and we will also use Moodle and/or Microsoft Teams.

If we want to share more general information that is relevant to all students, we will use

Moodle and/or Microsoft Teams. You will be registered on Moodle for a general

information page for your year, and important administration information will be shared

there.

We may sometimes ask you to meet us, and we will schedule a meeting that suits both of

us – either in person or online through Microsoft Teams.

How you should get in touch with us

If you have queries about a module, and the information is not already available on Moodle

or Microsoft Teams, you should contact your lecturer/tutor. Microsoft Teams or email is

best if the query is straightforward. Your course year handbook and the Department of

Geography website has a full list of contact details.

If the query is more complicated, it is a good idea to use drop-in/office hours. Drop-

in/Office hours are times that staff members have set aside just for you. A full list of drop-

in/office hours is available on Moodle and on the Department of Geography website.
