MEDIATION

12 week part-time course where participants develop the knowledge and skills required for the successful mediation of conflicts and disputes. In addition to understanding current concepts, policy and good practice relating to mediation, participants will develop the critical skills required to be an effective mediator.

Who is this micro-credential for?

- Professionals interested in developing the skills to work with others to resolve disputes constructively
- Professionals across various industries seeking to upskill for career development
- Professionals aspiring to reskill and become a mediator as a new career path (following a separate professional assessment of skills at the end of the course, participants can apply to join the Mediators' Institute of Ireland)
- People wishing to develop a supportive peer learning network and apply the learning in practical ways across various areas of their lives

Why should you do this course?

Expand your knowledge about the process of conflict resolution and develop your practical skills for successful dispute resolution in a structured learning environment. Build your confidence to address conflicts across various areas of your life and help others resolve conflicts. Expand your network of likeminded peers and participate in peer to peer learning activities.

Course delivery

This course commences on Saturday, 1 October 2022 and teaching will conclude on Saturday, 10 December 2022. This course will be delivered in person from 9.30am-4.30pm on Saturdays (1 October, 15 October, 5 November, 19 November, 3 December, 10 December). Online classes will take place from 6pm-8.30pm on Tuesday evenings (4 October, 25 October, 15 November).

Entry requirements




Applicants should have a minimum 2.2 grade, honours (level 8) degree. However, this course is also open to experienced professionals who do not hold a primary degree.
