Master of Education: Research in Practice

MH54L (90 Credits)

The Master of Education is a **part-time**, two-year (90 credits) course. Underpinned by the philosophy of Friedrich Froebel, his contemporaries and later scholars, this programme will specifically explore Action Research in its many forms within educational settings. Opportunities will exist for participants to further develop skills at a higher level in order to inspire transformative practi-

es within educational settings. Participants will be supported to critically reflect on their own practice, share best practices among education professionals and respond to the need for contextually relevant research, its valuable contribution to the system both in Ireland and further afield.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

This programme is primarily aimed at candidates who are working in the Primary and Early Childhood Education sectors and who wish to develop their practice through Action Research. Candidates are required to be in regular employment in an educational setting and to meet the criteria listed below:

1. A level 8 degree in Early Childhood Education with a minimum grade level of 2:1.
