Assistance will be provided on arrival with finding the local supermarkets and buying various foods in them. Some ensemble cooking will also be organized.

Cultural trips


All coaches trips will be covered under the summer school as well as any entrance fees on those visits.

Some facts about Maynooth University

Maynooth University is an internationally recognised institution located 25 kilometres outside of Dublin, Ireland, and is the nation's fastest growing university. One of four constituent universities of the National University of Ireland, Maynooth University in 2019 placed #43 in the global top 100 universities under 50 years old in the Times Higher Education World University Rankings.



Maynooth is situated about 20km from Dublin city centre. It is on the periphery of the city so it offers a blend of the urban and suburban lifestyles. The university itself was set up in 1795 and the Computer Science department opened in 1987. Maynooth town has a population of 25,000 people.

The accommodation is on-campus in our student residences



The weather in August has a high of 18° and lows of 11°. The weather can be changeable and so it can be sunny and raining all in the one day. Remember to bring a waterproof jacket, hat or umbrella. Also, sunrise is about 5:45am and it will stay bright until 9:15pm.
