The Student Services Centre is located on the North Campus of the University behind the John Hume Building. It is attached to MAP lodge. Counselling:

The team of professional Counsellors are available to students and can be contacted by telephone or the 'call me' facility on the website. The service offers a confidential, free of charge, counselling service by a team of professional counsellors. Chaplaincy Service:

The university Chaplain, Ciarán Coughlan is available to support students and offers a friendly, approachable, and non-judgemental listening ear. The Student Support Officer offers one to one meetings with students and provides personal and practical advice and guidance.
