The city of Valencia

Valencia is one of the most vibrant, forward-thinking and cosmopolitan cities in Spain. It is the country's third largest city and has a heritage, culture and nightlife to rival the best cities in Europe. Valencia is very proud of its dedication to forward thinking architecture and cultural projects. The world famous City of Arts and Sciences has to be seen to be believed. It is a cultural center stretching over 2 km and made up of buildings and open spaces that look like they are straight out of a science fiction film.



The city is also a great place to head if you fancy relaxing in the outdoors. Not only does it boast 13 km of golden sandy beaches, there are also parks and gardens throughout the city offering tranquility and beauty.

The riverbed of the River Turia has been dried out and now offers 9 km of parks and botanical gardens that cut right through the heart of the city.



Valencia is situated by the Mediterranean Sea, just in front of the astonishing Balearics Islands. It is almost 350 km far both from Madrid and Barcelona. Valencia train station is connected with all main domestic destinations. It takes only 1 hour and 20 minutes to get to Madrid by speed train (AVE)!



Valencia is a relatively small city. However, if you don't want to go on foot, public transport is a good idea.

There are several ways to travel round the city:

- The underground (Metro) has several lines and covers most of the city. It is one of the quickest and easiest ways to get around it.
- If you prefer to take a bus, this will offer you the opportunity to get around the city whilst sightseeing as you travel.
- There are some options that offer you limited or unlimited use of buses, tram or metro, but it depends on the period of use. Check the nearest Valencia Tourist Info to decide what is most convenient for you.

Application and Learning agreement

Every incoming student must already have completed the online application process before arriving at the UCV. This includes our internal document, the electronic learning agreement (LA).

Once you have done this, if you need **to make any changes to your LA**, first it must be approved by both your UCV coordinator and your home coordinator (you can do it by e-mail). After that, to do the changes on your Learning agreement- internal document, please, go to the following link: <https://www.ucv.es/internacional/login.aspx> , fill it in with your username and password. Follow the same steps you did the first time: go to **Learning Agreement** on the UCV page and enter your e-mail and password. You will be able to do any changes you have decided.



Official Enrolment

Incoming students may go to classes before doing their official registration. When you are sure about the courses you are going to follow, you should go to see your UCV coordinator. He/she is the person in charge of doing your official enrolment. At the end of the process he/she will give you a document, called "*justificante de matrícula*" with the list of matters included on it.

Please, check and read it carefully. On this document, you will find our information about: the password to access **your personal intranet** (see below), as well as information on how to make your photo (to get **your UCV student card**) and how to activate **your UCV mail box**.

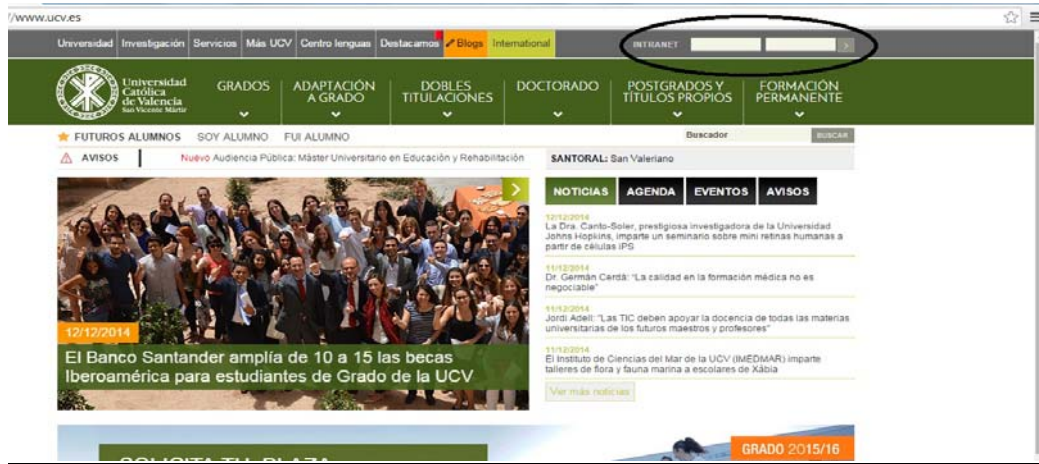
Modification of your stay period

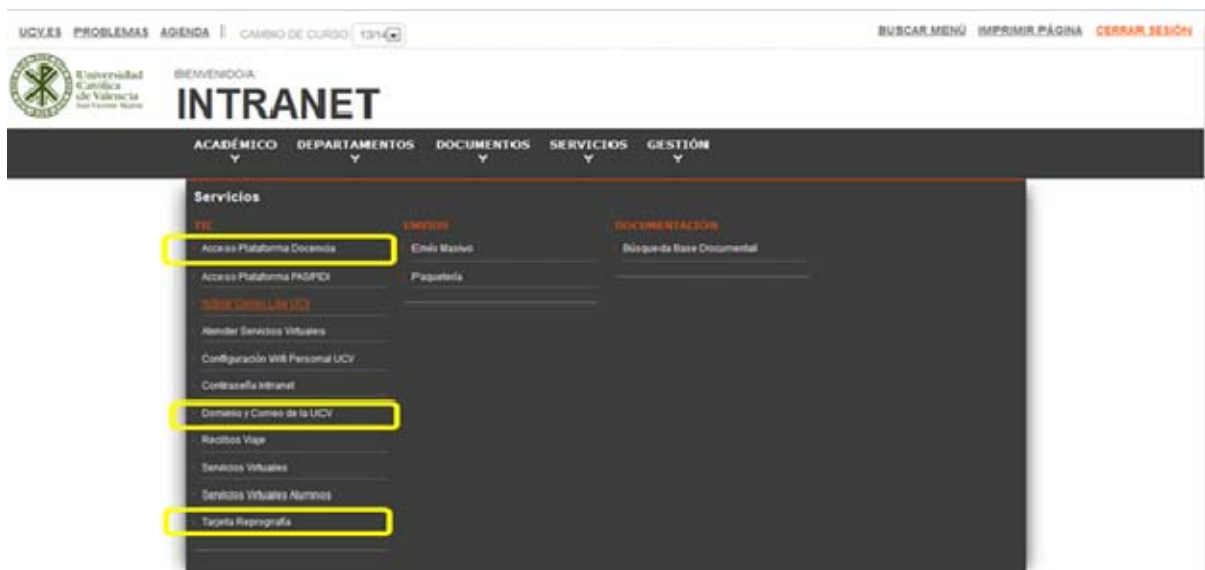


The UCV Intranet

On the Intranet you can find lot of academic information and services about the UCV.
The access is done through our web page:

Through it, you are able to find information about:

- 1) Access the **Academic Platform** (Virtual Campus). This gives you all the academic information regarding the courses you are following at the UCV: interesting academic dates, courses information and direct e-mail contact with your teachers are available on there.

You should go to the UCV website, www.ucv.es, and click on “**Campus Virtual UCV Net**” (at the bottom of the page). You can access this with your user name and password that were given to you when you completed the official registration at UCV. To top it up, please go to Conserjería (Reception Desk) at the entrance of the campus.



2) **Students' UCV card (*Tarjeta Reprográfica*)**

This card allows you to have access to the different services provided by the University: photocopy service, library and computer lab. Also you can use it to have some interesting prices for students in Valencia (transport, cine ...).



3) You can also activate your UCV **e-mail address** by clicking on ***Dominio y Correo de la UCV.***

How to get the UCV student's card:

1st step:

You have to be enrolled at our institution through the international coordinator. The international coordinator confirms your UCV-learning agreement and does your enrolment at UCV.

2nd step:

With your username and password given on the enrolment form, enter to the intranet and go to *Departamentos* and click on *Datos personales*. There you could find the following information: *usuario* and *ticket*, to do your digital photo on the photo boxes located in some of our Campuses (St Ursula, San Juan Bautista, San Carlos, Godella and Torrent).

3rd step:

You will receive an e-mail from the International office, where the student's card will arrive.

4th step:

Once you have your UCV card with you, do not forget to activate it in your Intranet, please, go to **Servicios Virtuales** and click on **Activar tarjeta** (with your user name and password).



Changing your courses after enrolment at the UCV

If you have already been enrolled by your international coordinator at UCV, and you would like to change some courses, firstly you will need permission from both, your home and your UCV coordinators.

Secondly, you must take an appointment with your UCV coordinator to show him/her the proposal and the coordinator will do the changes (deleted/ added courses) on your digital enrolment, at the intranet. At the end, please check your “*justificante de matricula*”, it will be included all the courses in it.

At the end of your stay at UCV, after the official dates, **the transcript of records (ToR)** will be created with the following information: name of the subject, number of credits and qualification obtained. This official document will be send by ordinary post directly to your international home office.

1st semester: beginning of September – mid-January (exams period included)

2nd semester: end of January- mid-July (exams period included)

Spanish courses/DELE Certificates

If you are a non-native Spanish speaker you will be required to provide a B1 Diploma of *Spanish as a Foreign Language* (DELE), not older than 2 years, which proves your level of proficiency in the Spanish language and which is awarded by the Spanish Ministry of Education and Science.

If you do not have this certificate, you should have the Spanish language skills that allow you to take courses in Spanish.





General Services you may find at the UCV

1. LIBRARY

There is one library almost in each campus.

To borrow books you will need your UCV Student Card.

You can also check list of available documents in the computer of the library or in https://www.ucv.es/alexandria/doc_ini.aspx

2. PHOTOCOPY SERVICE

To print out documents and make photocopies the UCV Student Card is also needed.

Check at your campus where the Photocopy service is located.

3. COMPUTER LAB

There is one computer lab in almost in each campus.

You may use your username and the password to log into the UCV computers.

4. SPORTS ACTIVITIES (SAFD)

5. CENTRO DE LENGUAS (LANGUAGE CENTER) offers 6 ECTS-Spanish Courses for all incoming students who are willing to improve their level of Spanish.

Some levels are offered to our incoming students: A2- B1 - B2 and **DELE B2**

These Spanish Courses (*Curso de Español para Extranjeros*) run in both semesters (Spring and/or Fall).

6. BUDDY PROGRAM

Thank you to all of you taking part of the program!

This program is meant to offer our International students a mentor service during their stay at the UCV. If you have joined the Buddy Program you have already been assigned a Buddy which will give you a hand in both academic and social issues.

In the case you are staying with us for the whole academic year, you still have the possibility to apply for the 2nd semester.

Health Insurance information

Non- EU residents must have a medical insurance to enter in Spain. You can obtain it in your country, or you can ask the International Center to help you with this procedure.

If you are an EU citizen, you are covered by the European Health Service. You must ask for your **European Health Card** (valid for one year) before leaving your country. You can use it to receive medical services either in Spain or in any other EU country.

In Spain, health care is provided at *Centros de Atención Primaria* (Primary Health Care Centers, or CAPs) and Hospitals. **CAPs** have fixed opening hours and you will be assigned one depending on where you live. Check your nearest *Centro de Salud* on:

If you need to see a General Practitioner (Family Doctor), you should ask at your CAP to be assigned one. If you have an urgent problem but it is not an emergency, the professionals at your CAP can see you during opening hours.

Hospitals give assistance for emergencies, and you should go there when you have a serious emergency, with your European Health Card. You should only go to the emergency services when you really need them, that way overcrowding of hospitals can be avoided.

If you need medical assistance, it is important to bring with you a copy of your medical insurance or medical card, since you may be asked to do so give it at the medical center.
