The Postgraduate Certificate in Programme Design and Validation (PDV) is a blended, part-time certificate that is run in partnership with the Department of Adult and Community Education, Maynooth University and the Further Education Support Service (FESS). It is designed to meet the needs of people working in the adult, community and further education sector who have a direct role in the design and validation of accredited further education programmes including traineeship and apprenticeship programmes.

It is intended that completion of the programme will enhance participants employability and promotion prospects in the FET sector generally.

PROGRAMME STRUCTURE

The programme is offered part-time over two semesters. It will be blended delivery online via MS Teams and in-person day-long workshops. It will commence in October 2024 with 8 in-person programme days (Fridays 10am – 4pm) in Maynooth University campus, and 7 online programme mornings (Fridays 10am-12.30pm). The programme team and students will also use the Moodle online platform registered to Maynooth University.

Adult education participative and dialogical methodologies will be used for delivery both online and in workshops. The online dimension will be interactive and include activities that enhance student learning through active participation in webinars, discussion forums and other exercises. A key feature of the programme is its participatory, dialogic approach.
